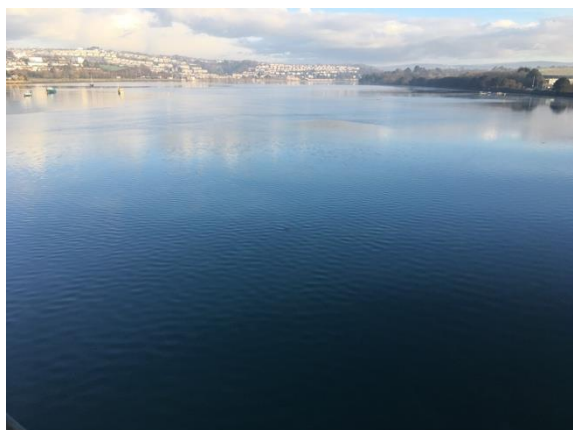

Because of tide, light and race distance issues the following have been agreed with the South Coast Championship Committee:

1. **All Championship events to be held over a 1500m course.**

Reason – Maximum length of a straight course with a reasonable accessible finish line for umpires.

2. **All Open events to be held over a 1000m course.**

Reason – Tidal and light issues on Sat 6th Sept 2025 require the event to be condensed into 5hr max window.

3. **No alternative championship courses.**

A check of the weather forecast on Mon 1st Sept 2025 12.00 will be made. Based on this forecast a decision to keep with fine boats or switch to coastal boats shall be taken.

This shall be immediately relayed to all captains/entry secretaries via the WhatsApp channel setup from previous SCC.

(Reason – In the event of rough water due to strong winds the Regatta can still proceed if coastal boats are used. All clubs will need to be prepared for this possibility and communication between all affiliations will have to be paramount.)

This could lead to many single and pair events on Friday being cancelled.

4. **All race crews are subject to a Regatta Official Start Warning**

(Reason – We only have a narrow tidal window and any delays resulting from continued false starts will result in races towards the end of the regatta potentially not going ahead.)

Unfortunately stake boats will not be available for this event as in previous years.

Video on the start line will potentially be used to backup umpire's decisions for disqualification for deliberate and intentional distance advantage by rowing past the official start.

All Clubs to be fully briefed on start procedure at morning Captains' meeting to pass on to ALL COMPETITORS
